ness is one that I can sell (but why?), or pass on to my family," says Jerry. Adam says he'll be more than happy to keep the business afloat.

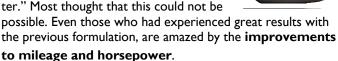

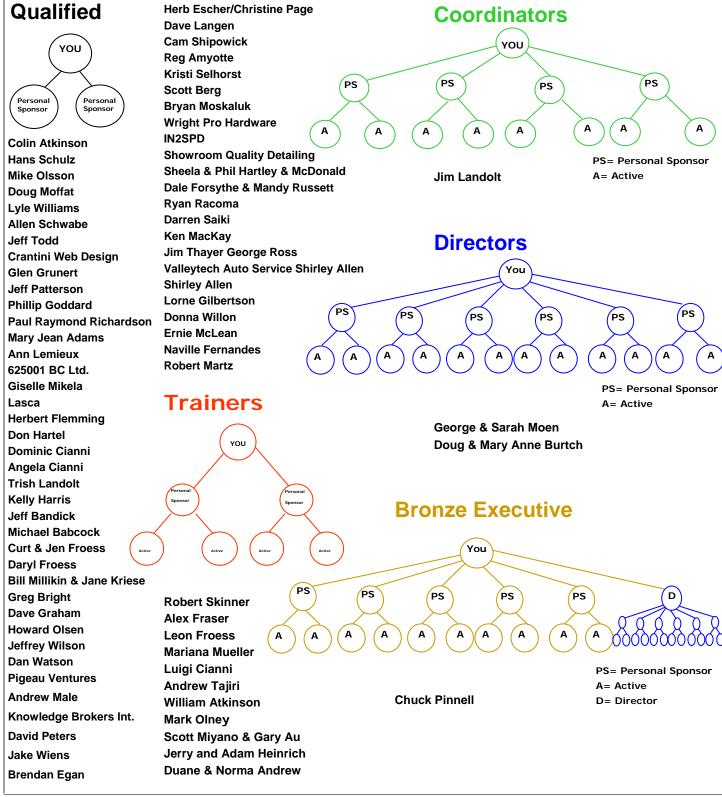

To be successful on the ice, a team has to be strong off the ice, and the New Westminster Bruins were led by one of the **best junior** coaches of all time, Ernie 'Punch' McLean. After a 15-year stint as the head coach of the Estevan Bruins, McLean made the move to New Westminster. "Punch" led the New Westminster Bruins to four consecutive WHL Championship titles from 1974-75 to 1977-78 and two Memorial Cup titles in 1977 and 1978. The championship New Westminster teams included future NHL stars Barry Beck, Stan Smyl, John Ogronick and Brad Maxwell. McLean also captured the WHL Championship title with the Estevan Bruins in 1967-68.

Ernie McLean is second all-time among WHL coaches in games coached with 1,067 and games won with 548 and was named WHL Coach of the Year in 1975-76.

At one time there were **80 players** in the NHL who had played under McLean during their junior careers.
