



I want to share my Bi-Tron experience with you. In my 1988 Ford F350 crewcab 4X4, I had **phenomenal results!** The most note worthy was that my transfer case was vibrating to the point of being able to feel it in the seat and floor boards and you couldn't have a conversation with out shouting. The transmission shop told me I would need to rebuild it at a cost of \$800 - \$1500! 





Great Bi-Tron Experience! and temperature reading normal!

My name is Riemer Faber, I am an avid hot rodder and amateur mechanic. I have always been a bit of a skeptic especially when it comes to "snake oil" products for cars. I have had an interest in Bi-Tron since I heard about it through guys at work. I was hesitant to try it out in my vehicle. Then I watched some of the internet videos and slowly came around to thinking that this might actually do what It claims to do! I have a fairly good grasp on chemistry as that was my major all through high school and some of college, so I understand what Bi-Tron claims to do, and after the other day I can say I know what Bi-Tron claims to do and that the claim is true. Bi-Tron actually does what It says it is supposed to do!

We were taking the kids to Manning Park the other day in my wife's Jeep Grand Cherokee. It has a 4.0l inline six, and about 320000 km on it. It has been running fairly well getting average mileage and having about as much power as can be expected for a vehicle of this size and weight. Recently, I had done some mechanic work for Jeff and he gave me some Bi-Tron to try in my own vehicle. Since we put more miles on my wife's Jeep, I put the Bi-Tron in the jeep. Well thats the lead in to the story, the rest will blow your mind, as a part time mechanic it left me speechless.

Our trip started in Aldergrove BC. The weather was warm and sunny. We drove east towards Manning Park. We were in a bit of a rush so I was driving slightly higher than posted speeds and perhaps not driving with fuel economy in mind. We had just crested the "Hope Slide Hill" heading east. It is a long and steep hill. Apparently, my wife's jeep had developed an oil leak or perhaps burned a 'bit' of oil in the past month. I had not had a chance to check the oil or do any maintenance other than add Bi-Tron and make sure the oil was topped up at that time (about three weeks ago.) Since I usually always monitor the gauges when driving I noticed that the oil gauge was fluctuating quite a bit during the drive, as we came to the top of the hill it was fully on 0 psi for pressure. We coasted past the crest and in neutral till we could turn off the road onto a level spot, my oil gauge still reading 0 psi,

I popped the hood fearing the worst, but there was no characteristic "my engine is WAY to hot smell." I thought perhaps the gauge had malfunctioned. That was until I pulled out the dipstick. BONE DRY, not even a drop on the tip. I thought I was in trouble and a cold sweat broke and I felt a huge knot in my stomach telling me that this was not normal and I was going to be in BIG trouble! With my 9 month pregnant wife in the truck and two boys wanting to get going, I calmly said "hmm that's odd." | closed the hood and we proceeded to drive another 40 km through the mountains' till Manning Park, where I purchased 4L of oil and slowly added them to the crank case. It took a little over two liters before the oil even registered on the dipstick.

I had driven 40 kilometers in the mountains with absolutely NO OIL in the crankcase.

The only thing preventing my engine from welding itself together was the Bi-Tron that had worked itself into the metal. With 4 fresh liters of oil in the jeep we drove back the 140 km trip back home. All the while I was wondering why didn't the engine seize on the hill? After the Manning park incident I did have an opportunity to examine the valve train of the jeep's 4.01 to see if there was anything damaged by the recent events. Nothing out of the ordinary (for 320 000km). The valve train looked fine. No burnt oil anywhere just some normal mild discoloring in the valve seals (which are plastic, Bi-Tron doesn't make anything for plastics yet do they?) The engine runs well, there are no knocks or noises and it still has all the compression it did when we purchased it many years ago.

While I am not much into the business of selling, I do have the opportunity to talk with people about the product and without fail I can tell people that I will definitely be one of Jeff's best promoters and customers! Bi-Tron does what it says it does, plain and simple! And it saved me and my engine, I plan to rebuild this motor later this summer, and I will be using Bi-Tron products again. MOST DEFINITELY.
