

an insignificant decision

Please Note: The following journey started as an insignificant, a small choice or decision. This decision could have just as easily been given a quick "NO" as it was given a "YES". Both the "NO" and "YES" have consequences. My "YES" had the following consequences, its up & downs and rewards. We all make these sort of decisions regularly almost without a 2nd thought. There were a number of such small decisions made before this one came along that lead me to this spot and I am very glad it has accomplished what it has. Yes, there is lots of room for improvement. Remember, that you start where you are presently standing. This outline is my results and the income mentioned is an approximate figure. The figures for the Founders & presidential shares are simply a wild guess. They still remain an UNKNOWN. The real figures will show up when we tentatively get our first cheque in July 2010. Commitment, persistence, stumbling, belief is what has accomplished this journey. Nevertheless this is the results so far of my insignificant decision; **Plan, envision and imagine a better result for** yourself; AWF

I am from Eastern Ontario, Glengarry County. In November 1998 we were in the Comox Valley, BC and I was introduced by Phil W. to a product called Bi-Tron of which I had have never heard, nor knew anything about. He indicated that Bitron was an oil based product that could save 10% on my fuel costs. He probably told me more but this is what I remember. At the time we were driving across the country from Courtenay, BC to Lancaster, Ontario a round trip of 6,500 miles and saving 10% on my fuel costs on those trips really intrigued me. So I purchased the product and joined under Phil. At that time Bitron was sold by Nato out of Vancouver. That is now 11 years ago.

I started using Bitron and have never stopped. I let the product educate me slowly and surely. At that time I would not touch the business side of things with a 20 foot pole. I knew the product worked and I made sure I had a good supply of the products as well. In 1999 Nato for a variety of reasons went out of business. Over the next few years when ever I came across the Bitron products I bought them. In this interval efforts were made to keep it going by Teamglobe out of Australia and DDR out of Vancouver. I was an official distributor under these 3 managements.

In November 1998 I made an insignificant choice, a small choice to believe in a product I never heard of or knew nothing about. Eleven years of use has only increased that belief of what this product can do for those you choose to use it regularly.

The product works, it knows what it is supposed to do in the respective categories, engine parts in which it is used. Skepticism does not affect this product doing it's job. That skepticism only affects the viewer who uses that skepticism as a road block to his or her betterment.

Maybe I didn't know any better but I never questioned the potential of what this product could do for me. I simply allowed it to do what it was made to do and the results were on the whole simply GREAT.

On June 1st 1999 I got my present 1/2 ton truck, a 1997 GMC 4.3 Litre engine with manual transmission that had 37500 kms on it. Today Dec 31, 2009 this truck has 201225.2 kms on it. I have driven it a total of 163752.2 kms or 101,509.624 miles. Thus, I have been using the bitron products, namely gas, diesel, fuel conditioner, engine treatment, 2.4.6/powertrain & gear formulation as well as the Tire Safety Solution, now for over 101,509.624 miles. The TSS I have used most of that time. Maybe the 2.4.6/powertrain & gear formulations for at least 1/2 to 2/3 of that time.


In the past year, since October 2008 since we got the 4 tire pressure gauges that show green, my tires have stayed at a constant pressure within a pound now for a good 12 months as the tires do not look deflated in any manner even if they are off by a pound or so. Every time I have checked the air pressure in the tires they have been within proper range. Yes they have varied a pound or so, nevertheless they have been constant.

My truck is rated at about 15/16 mpg in town and 21 mpg on the highway.

with my truck.

These reduced fuel costs are approximate figures, are subject to change with the price of gas. Over the 11 years I have gone from an average of 17 mpg to an 10-11 year average of 24 mpg. Over the 101,509.624 miles travelled this is equivalent to not having to purchase 5971.154-4229.567= 1741.586 gallons of gas. At the present rate of gas on Dec 09 of 99.9 cents a litre or \$4.5454 a gallon this is a savings of \$7916.206 or 719.655 a year or 59.97 a month

When the price of gas was about 1.53 a litre the savings would have been in the vicinity of \$12,108.16 or when it was at 1.20 a litre the savings would have been in the vicinity of \$9496.594.



In the 12 months of 2009 I filled up about 7 or 8 times.

I have gained a reduced fuel, maintenance, downtime benefit of about \$7900.00 to 9400.00

Not every tank of gas got me good results. There was a number that got me no results, negative results. I did not let this fact deter my interest in using these excellent products


With these reduced fuel costs results I now basically average about every 3rd to 4th tank of gas FREE. My average fill up is in the \$90.00 range and this varies with the price of gas as well.

In November 2002 Dick Simmonds helped me fill an order and asked me to come in as a founder which I did.

I have been on 100 by autoship now for 7 years and just paid for my 8th year to Nov 2010. This recent Autoship cost was 1,815.50, thus average cost X 8 years =\$14,524.00 approximately.

I also was a Founder in Bitron and purchased the founders pack about 3 times at a cost of about \$5500.00. This was due to the rearranging of things at head office over the early years. Rhoda & I now have 11 Founders & presidential shares in which we are eligible to receive the benefits, in July 2010. What the value of those shares will actually be in July 2010 is anyones guess.

I have had 1,2,3 or more monthly cheques from Bitron each month now since January 2003, which is now going on 8 years. At present in 2009 you choose when you get your cheques sent to you from your e wallet.




Since the 1st of October till Nov 20th I have retailed a good \$1000.00 in bi-tron products.

Over these 7 years I have averaged in retail sales and my commissions an average of around \$7500.00 a year =\$52,500.00

The above mentioned figures are approximate, your long term results will also be approximate

So what was the results of my insignificant decision to use Bitron in November 1998?

As of today, Dec 31/09 that insignificant decision has lead me getting to the level in Bitron of Director/Bronze/6 Star as well as back down to coordinator/1 star, losing 3/4 founders in that process. I am presently a Bitron/Natureline 4 star. I have just under 2000 in my downline of which probably 90% + are inactive



I have put into Bitron purchases of about \$20,000.00 to \$25,000.00 for products, conferences, advertising, promotions etc.

I have gained in income, retail sales, commissions in the vicinity of \$50 to 55,000.00

In July 2010 we will be receiving out first of 3 yearly cheques from the Founders & presidential share for our 11 shares which could amount to anywhere from a low of about \$5500.00 or less to a high of \$10 to \$20,000.00 or maybe more. This figure is simply a wild guess on my part.

Putting all of this together, Summarizing

Was my insignificant decision, my small choice worth it! Darn tottin it was in many ways.

I was and am still am not a very aggressive promoter. I am a steady one. I help those who will accept my assistance.

In this journey I have learned a lot of things;

like Skepticism only hurts the one that uses it as a roadblock

the bitron products work & skepticism does not effort that performance

I have granted a lot of wishes

I have not quit

People on the whole come across have little faith or belief when it comes to the potential of what this product can do for them--- as it comes across as being to good to be true.

The beauty is that the Bitron products accomplishes it goals, but does so only when it is allowed to do so by the person who choses to use it in their car, truck, equipment.

Bitron seems to have a mind of its own when allowed to do its job.

The person with heavy skepticism, unbelief who is conned, convinced into using the product and puts it in his vehicle, is almost like the fact that even thou the product is in the vehicle, the mindset of the skeptic is like that product never left the shelf to begin with. The product is working but the Mindset is blocked, blinded from realizing the results.

It's your Natureline Business and your goals to build it as large as you want to make it, however, without goals and your willingness to work it is certain to fail.

Thus, set your goals now and set a timetable to meet those goals. (Star 1 to Star 8, etc.)

Share your goals with your spouse, up line and friends that want to see you get ahead!

Your goal must be written down.


It must **be specific.** The more detail the better.

The ball in Time Square has dropped, and brought to a close yet another year. Sadness for some an ending, a conclusion, a finale. For others 'tis just the opposite ... The beginning.
